INFORMATIONS PRATIQUES

How to access the Salle du Conseil l'IUT de Dijion?

Access by road:

Fast motorway access is provided:

- from Paris via the A6
- from Lille / Belgium by A26 and A5
- from Metz-Luxembourg via the A31
- Strasbourg / Germany by the A36
- Geneva by the A40 and A39

Access to the campus of Dijon by the East ring road, direction Dijon center then University.

Access by public transport:


The T1 line (Gare <> Quétigny) from the **tramway** starts at the SNCF train station, crosses the city center, to arrive at the ERASME stop 500 m from the festival. It takes about 15 minutes to complete the journey.

Several Divia network **bus lines** serve the Dijon campus:

- Line 5 Talant Dullin <> Campus, serves the south of the campus. It allows quick access from the city center (Place Darcy less than 500 m from the train station, Liberation Square, Theater and Wilson).
- Corol connects the main neighborhoods and amenities without going through the city center.
- Full Moon, the line of night owls: from September to June, the nights of Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays from 1:30 to 5:30, an hourly bus connects the campus to the Golden Fleece, passing by the main places of downtown nightlife.
